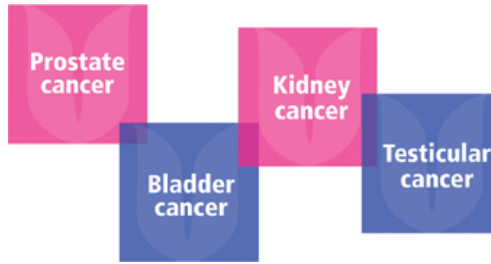


UCARE CONCERT
